4. Anti-raging undertaking by Student & Parent.
5. Covid related undertaking by Parent & student.
6. Negative Covid RT-PCR report preferably done within last 72 hours [ie not earlier than 25th Dec 2020].
7. 5 recent passport size photographs.

Fees to be paid at time of registration:

For all students:

Registration Fees	Rs. 2000/- One Time
University Development Fee	Rs. 1000/- Per Year
Library/Library Caution Money	Rs. 2500/- One Time (Refundable)

For students availing Hostel facilities #:

Non-AC Hostel	Rs 20000/- + Rs. 40,000/-*	= Rs 60000/- Per year
AC- Hostel	Rs 49000/- + Rs. 40,000/-*	= Rs 89000/- Per year
Caution Deposit		= Rs.20000/- [Refundable]

Type of hostel provided will be subject to availability.

*Mess fees –Availing mess facility is mandatory for the students staying in hostel.
